What are the biggest trends impacting LNG in 2024 and how should the global industry respond to them?

The growing role of regulatory requirements - as exemplified by the adoption of the EU Methane Regulation - is the most significant recent development in the business, which has had little exposure to the reality of regulatory intervention, but will need to learn how to navigate it to sustain growth in the coming years.

• How do you see the LNG sector evolving in the next ten years?

The LNG sector has a key role to play in a decarbonising world, and the industry's ability to prioritise transparency and mitigation of GHG emissions will be one of the key factors in ensuring the long-term prosperity of the business.
